<u>Cultural Information –</u> <u>Adenia</u>

<u>Light:</u>	Full to partial sun, south east or western exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain indoor temperatures above 45°.
Humidity:	Humidity is not an issue in its culture
Watering:	Bring the soil to visual dryness between waterings during the active growing season. During winter plant can be kept dryer where the soil is allowed to dry out completely.
Fertilizer:	Feed during the active growing season with a balanced fertilizer. They are not heavy feeders but do benefit from some fertilizer. Once a month is usually adequate.
Pruning:	The vining stems can be pruned as need to contain the size and height.
Insects and Disease:	Mealybugs and thrip can be a problem
Comments	An easy caudiciform to grow. Grow in a well drained potting mix and during the winter when not in active growth and temperatures are cooler grow dryer.
