<u>Cultural Information – Bauhinia</u> (baw-HIN-ee-uh)

<u>Light:</u>	Full sun, a southern exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain indoor temperatures above 60°.
Humidity:	Bauhinia can tolerate wide swings in relative humidity. As a general rule maintain relative humidity above 50%.
Watering:	Bring potting mix to visual dryness between watering and then thoroughly saturate the soil until some water trickles from the bottom of the pot.
Fertilizer:	Moderate levels of fertilizer. Feed every two weeks or once a month with a balance fertilizer no higher than 15-15-15 during the growing season. Discontinue in winter when growth is slow.
Pruning:	Both tree form and vining can be pruned any time the growth is excessive. Pruning will slow down flowering.
Insects and Disease:	Few problems with insects except mealybug if near infected plants. Diseases are generally not a problem.
Comments	Bauhinia are easy plants to grow in pots. They need full sun and a slight dry period between waterings. Iron chlorosis can present itself in the winter under cool conditions. This usually self corrects as the days lengthen.
