

## Cultural Information- Blechnum (BLEK-num)

Light:	Partial sun, an eastern or western exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain temperatures above 60°.
Humidity:	Preferably 50% or higher; however, prefers high humidity.
Watering:	Keep evenly moist. The fronds suffer if they dry out too much. Having them sit in water will help keep them moist.
Fertilizer:	They are light feeders; ¼ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water once a month. Use a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or Dyna-Gro Liquid Grow Plant Food 7-9-5.
Pruning:	If the fronds die, simply trim them.
Insects and Disease:	Susceptible to scale and root rot.
Comments:	These are great indoor plants that don't require a lot of light but do require attention to watering and humidity.
