<u>Cultural Information- Bletilla</u> (bleh-TIL-uh)

| <u>Light:</u> | Full to partial sun; a southern, eastern or western exposure. |
|----------------------|---|
| Temperature: | Minimum indoor temperature above 35°. |
| Humidity: | Tolerant to wide swings in humidity. Humidity is not and issue when grown as a garden plant. |
| Watering: | Keep soil evenly moist being sure not to put it under severe drought stress. Be sure the soil it is planted in is well drained. |
| Fertilizer: | Light feeders. If they are grown in partial sun, a spring application of a balanced organic fertilizer is all that is needed. Use a balanced fertilizer no higher than a 15-15. |
| Pruning: | Old flower canes can be removed other that that, little pruning is needed. |
| Insects and Disease: | Plants are not bothered by either insects or diseases. |
| Comments: | This easy-to-grow garden orchid needs only well drained soil and moderate light. Pay attention to watering during periods of extreme dryness, and a light mulch will help in wintering over this plant in areas above Zone 6. |
