## <u>Cultural Information – Carmona</u> (car-MOH-nah)

<u>Light:</u>	Full or partial sun; a southern, eastern or western exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain indoor temperatures above 60°.
Humidity:	Generally keep the humidity above 50%, although they will tolerate lower levels for short period without harm.
Watering:	Bring the surface of the soil to visual dryness between waterings and then thoroughly saturate the mix. If grown as a bonsai, pay careful attention to the watering as they can go from surface visual dryness to complete dryness very quickly and this can harm the plant.
Fertilizer:	Moderate amounts of fertilizer. Feed weekly or biweekly with a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or lower as long as the light levels are high. Discontinue feed under low light and cool temperatures.
Pruning:	Prune plants as needed to maintain form.
Insects and Disease:	Few problems with insects; mealy bugs can be an issue if other infected plants are nearby. With proper watering and light, there are few problems with root or foliar diseases.
Comments	Carmona microphylla or 'Fukien Tea' is an easy plant to grow provided it is kept warm above 60° and has some direct sunlight in its growing area. Be sure to water accurately especially when grown as a bonsai. They are great plants to shape and train into bonsai forms.
