

## Cultural Information- Citharexylum (sith-uh-REKS-il-um)

| Light:               | Full sun, a southern exposure.                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                               |

| Temperature:         | Maintain indoor temperatures above 50°.                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                      |
| Humidity:            | Best to maintain humidity above 50% although it will tolerate lower levels without harm.                                                                                                                                                                                                                     |
| Watering:            | Bring the soil to visual dryness between waterings and then thoroughly saturate.                                                                                                                                                                                                                             |
| <u>Fertilizer:</u>   | Moderate to heavy feeder under warmth and high light.<br>Feed with a balanced fertilizer at regular intervals<br>through its active growing season. For northern<br>growers, discontinue during the winter. Use a balanced<br>fertilizer no higher than a 15-15-15 or a blooming<br>fertilizer like a 7-9-5. |
| Pruning:             | If necessary, prune in late winter so as to not disrupt<br>the flowering cycle. Can be pruned any time growth is<br>excessive.                                                                                                                                                                               |
| Insects and Disease: | They have susceptibility to spider mites, whitefly,<br>aphids and mealybugs. Foliar diseases and root<br>diseases are not a problem.                                                                                                                                                                         |
| Comments:            | Citharexylum is a highly fragrant plant that from spring<br>to fall adorns itself in chains of white flowers. High light<br>is critical for productive flowering.                                                                                                                                            |
