<u>Cultural Information- Cordyline</u> (kor-di-LY-nee)

<u>Light:</u>	Full sun, partial sun, or shade, a southern, eastern, western or northern exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain indoor temperatures above 50°. Will tolerate temperatures. Maintain below freezing into the high 20's.
Humidity:	Best to maintain humidity above 50% although it will tolerate lower levels without harm.
Watering:	Bring the soil to visual dryness between waterings and then thoroughly saturate. Tolerant of wide swings in soil moisture.
Fertilizer:	Moderate feeders under warmth and high light. Feed with a balanced fertilizer no higher than a 15-15-15 at regular intervals through it active growing season. For northern growers, discontinue during the winter.
Pruning:	Prune any time height is excessive. Pruning does help create a multi-branched specimen.
Insects and Disease:	Insects or diseases do not bother them.
Comments:	Cordyline are easy plants to grow and tolerate a wide range of environmental conditions. They are, however, somewhat slow growing.
