<u>Cultural Information – Drosera</u> (DROSS-er-uh)

<u>Light:</u>	Full sun is necessary, a southern exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain a minimum temperature of 40°. Although they can tolerate cool temperatures, it is better to keep them above 60° for active growth.
Humidity:	Preferably 50% or higher; however, since they are grown in water, humidity is not an issue.
Watering:	They are bog plants and need to be kept moist at all times. It's best to grow them in a saucer of water. Also, use non- chlorinated water to improve their growth.
Fertilizer:	Little to no fertilizer is preferred. Too much fertilizer can harm them.
Pruning:	Pruning is not necessary.
Insects and Disease:	They capture insects and are not bothered by insects.
Comments	Keep them wet with pure, clean water for best growth.
