## <u>Cultural Information – Gerrardanthus</u> (jer-rar-DANTH-us)

<u>Light:</u>	Full sun, a southern exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain temperatures above 60°.
Humidity:	They are not affected by low humidity. They will take high levels of humidity as long as the soil is dry.
Watering:	Water only when the soil is visually dry. They do not want constantly moist soil, as they are dry land plants. When watering, thoroughly saturate soil until a little water runs out of the bottom of the pot. Growing in a clay pot will help maintain a healthy root system.
Fertilizer:	Monthly at ¼ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water. Careful not to over-feed. Excessive fertilization will kill this plant. Use a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or a 7-9-5. Do not fertilize during the winter.
Pruning:	The climbing vine can be pruned if growth is excessive.
Insects and Disease:	They are susceptible to white fly and spider mite. They are also susceptible to root rot and stem rot usually from excessive water or fertilizer.
Comments	Neglect this plant and it will thrive.
