<u>Cultural Information – Huernia</u> (hew-ERN-ee-uh)

<u>Light:</u>	Full or partial sun, a southern, eastern or western exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain temperatures above 50°
Humidity:	Humidity is not an issue in culture.
Watering:	Bring potting mix to dryness between waterings then thoroughly saturate the soil until some water trickles from the bottom of the pot. Growing in a clay pot will help ensure a healthy root system. Grow drier during the winter and moister during the summer.
Fertilizer:	Low levels of fertilizer. Once a month with a diluted solution from spring through fall. Use a balanced fertilizer no higher than 15-15-15.
Pruning:	Little if any pruning needed. Old and very large plants can be divided or stem can be cut back to maintain size.
Insects and Disease:	Few if any problems with insects. Root rot is a problem if kept too wet, especially during the winter.
Comments	Easy plants to grow. Just don't over water and grow in good light. Perfect for windowsill culture.
