# Cultural Information - Lindernia (lin-DERN-ee-uh) 

| Light: | Full to partial sun, a southern, eastern or western exposure. |
| :--- | :--- |
| Temperature: | Maintain indoor temperatures above $50^{\circ}$. |
| Humidity: | Preferably $50 \%$ or higher; however, they will tolerate low levels of <br> humidity for a short time. |
| Watering: | Keep evenly moist. This plant can be grown aquatically on the edges <br> of a pond. Do not expose it to severe wilt. |
| Fertilizer: | They are moderate feeders that require $1 / 2$ tsp of fertilizer per gallon <br> of water twice a month of a balanced fertilizer like a $15-15-15$ or a <br> blooming fertilizer like a $7-9-5$. During the summer, increase <br> frequency of fed to once a week. |
| Pruning: | Prune back at anytime, especially if the trailing stems become too <br> long. |
| $\underline{\text { Insects and }} \boldsymbol{\text { Disease: }}$ | No susceptibility to insects or disease. |
| $\underline{\text { Comments }}$ | Bright light increases flowering. |
