## <u>Cultural Information – Michelia</u> (my-KEE-lee-uh)

| Light:               | Full or partial sun, a southern, eastern or western exposure.   |
|----------------------|---|
| Temperature:         | Maintain indoor temperatures above 35°; however, they will tolerate cooler temperatures during the winter.  |
| <u>Humidity:</u>     | Preferably 50% or higher; however, they will tolerate low levels without harm.  |
| Watering:            | Bring the soil to a state of visual dryness between waterings, when watering, thoroughly saturate the soil until some water trickles from the bottom of the pot.  |
| Fertilizer:          | They need moderate levels of fertilizer. Give them more under high light. Generally fertilize with ½ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water once a week. Use a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or a blooming fertilizer like a 7-9-5. Discontinue feeding during the winter. |
| Pruning:             | Prune to maintain shape; excessive pruning reduces flowering.   |
| Insects and Disease: | They are susceptible to mealy bugs. Spray with Pure Neem Oil at the first sign of infestation.  |
| Comments             | Michelia has some difficulty with root diseases, especially when there is excessive moisture. Be sure to water as indicated above. Repot only when plant has completely filled the pot.   |
