## <u>Cultural Information – Plumbago</u> (plum-BAY-goh)

Light:	Full sun, a southern exposure, is necessary.
Temperature:	Maintain indoor temperatures above 45°.
Humidity:	Preferably 50% of higher; however, they will tolerate low levels with no harm.
Watering:	Bring soil to a state of visual dryness between watering. When watering, thoroughly saturate soil until a little water runs out of the bottom of the pot. Growing in a clay pot will help maintain a healthy root system.
Fertilizer:	Fertilize with ½ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water once a week when in active growth and temperatures are warm. Use a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or a blooming fertilizer like a 7-9-5. Discontinue in winter, especially under short days and cool night temperatures.
Pruning:	Repot once the plant has completely filled the pot and prune back in late winter or early spring. Prune hard if growth is excessive. Pruning encourages flowering.
Insects and Disease:	Few problems with insects.
Comments	Makes an excellent standard or can be used in a basket or a mixed container.
