<u>Cultural Information- Polyscias</u> (pol-ISS-skee-as)

<u>Light:</u>	Partial sun to shade, eastern, western or northern exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain indoor temperatures above 60° although they can take lower temperature to above freezing for short periods.
Humidity:	Relative humidity above 50% is best although they can tolerate lower levels without harm.
Watering:	Water when media is dry or almost dry then thoroughly saturate. Keep drier in winter and increase watering in summer.
Fertilizer:	Moderate to low feeders. Fertilize with a diluted balanced fertilizer from spring through fall every 2 weeks. If growing in shade err on the low side.
Pruning:	Plant can be pruned back as needed to maintain size. Pruning will also encourage a full specimen.
Insects and Disease:	Few problems with insects. They are susceptible to root disease if kept too wet. Be sure there is a dry period between waterings.
Comments:	The ming aralias are great indoor plants that tolerate the dryness and low light of the modern home and still perform well. Best to keep them in a window preferably with some sunlight and be sure that the soil gets to dry out a little between waterings
