<u>Cultural Information – Porphyrocoma</u> (por-fye-roh-COH-mah)

| <u>Light:</u> | Full sun, partial sun or shade, a southern, eastern, western or northern exposure. |
|----------------------|---|
| Temperature: | Maintain indoor temperatures above 60°. |
| Humidity: | Preferably 50% of higher; however, they will tolerate low levels with no harm. |
| Watering: | Bring soil to a state of visual dryness between watering. When watering, thoroughly saturate soil until a little water runs out of the bottom of the pot. Growing in a clay pot will help maintain a healthy root system. |
| Fertilizer: | Fertilize once every two weeks with ½ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water. Use a balanced fertilizer lie a 15-15-15 or a blooming fertilizer like a 7-9-5. |
| Pruning: | Prune whenever growth is excessive. They respond well to pruning. Deadhead spent flowers. |
| Insects and Disease: | For the most part, they are not susceptible to insects and diseases. |
