## <u>Cultural Information – Portulacaria "Mini Jade"</u> (por-tew-luh-KAR-ee-uh)

<u>Light:</u>	Full or partial sun, a southern, eastern or western exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain indoor temperatures above 40°. Under cool temperature be sure the soil is kept on the dry side.
Humidity:	Tolerates low humidity with ease.
Watering:	Dry the soil between waterings and then thoroughly saturate the potting mix until some water trickles from the bottom of the pot.
Fertilizer:	A moderate feeder. Feed spring to fall with a balance dilute fertilizer no higher than 15-15-15 biweekly or monthly or top dress with an organic granular a few times during the growing season.
Pruning:	Plants can be pruned back to maintain size and form as needed. It does have a somewhat sprawling habit so to contain it as a potted plant is does need periodic trimming.
Insects and Disease:	Few problems with insects or diseases.
Comments	This is a dryland plant that is easy to grow and tolerant to neglectful watering. It also makes a great bonsai as it produces a wood trunk quickly as well as horizontal branches with little effort.
