<u>Cultural Information – Scaevola</u> (skee-VOH-luh)

<u>Light:</u>	Full sun, a southern exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain indoor temperatures above 40°.
Humidity:	Preferably 50% of higher; however, they will tolerate low levels with no harm.
Watering:	Bring soil to a state of visual dryness between watering. When watering, thoroughly saturate soil until a little water runs out of the bottom of the pot. Growing in a clay pot will help maintain a healthy root system.
Fertilizer:	Fertilize with ½ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water once a week. Use a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or a blooming fertilizer like a 7-9-5.
Pruning:	Prune anytime growth is excessive or in the spring or late winter so as to not disrupt flowering.
Insects and Disease:	Resistant to most insects and diseases.
Comments	Flowers in the longer day-length of summer. A great plant for summer mixed containers or hanging baskets. They need warmer light to flower well and high soil fertility.
