

Cultural Information – Schlumbergera (shlum-BER-ger-uh)

-	
Light:	Partial sun or shade, an eastern, western or northern exposure.
Temperature:	Maintain indoor temperatures above 35°. Flowering is induced by cool
	night temperatures (35° to 55°) and the shortened daylight of winter.
Humidity:	As they are succulents, humidity is not an issue.
Watering:	Bring soil to a state of visual dryness between watering. When watering, thoroughly saturate soil until a little water runs out of the bottom of the
	pot. Growing in a clay pot will help maintain a healthy root system.
Fertilizer:	Fertilize once every two weeks with ½ tsp of fertilizer per gallon of water. Use a balanced fertilizer like a 15-15-15 or a blooming fertilizer like a 7- 9-5.
Pruning:	Prune after flowering if needed.
Insects and Disease:	They do have susceptibly to mealy bugs and under damp conditions fungus can be a problem.
